Transformation of Australian healthcare from private payer to Universal Health was a huge turning point in Australian economic history. The single payer system never increased its price from a 2% levy set back in 1973 and the care is based on evidence-based practice.

Annual ratio of health dollars of GDP in 2013, rose to 2.8 % . GDP rose 2.2%, increasing Australia's healthcare share of GDP to 9.4%. While America spent 17.1% health care dollars of GDP- 1/6th. The greatest contraction of business throughout the Healthcare industry, was merging, or relocation of Health Care supply companies, and Health Insurance companies.

Incorporating IT systems , allows accurate tracking of patient services, promoting affordable care to greater numbers, democratizing health care.

An informed public is better able to make the right choices, through comparative shopping online, for doctors services, and health care facilities.' Health Grades' encourages online patient participation to improve services.

'Live' service with 24/7 cover improves centralized patient information and helps avoid excessive duplication of services, and wasteful practices witnessed over the past three or four decades, increasing incrementally with the rapid pace of change.

The key components of my recent 'virtual' care experience cost me nothing when I had a heart attack. They included a good relationship with my Walmart Pharmacist, and the ability to fully utilize my resources using a smartphone, caregivers and self-knowledge. The experience cost the health care system zero dollars. I got better sooner than if I took the traditional route.

This is what could be possible for many if sufficient education is given to end users.

I have had a left-sided stroke and metastatic breast cancer history, and I am currently in maintenance mode for my diastolic heart failure and Gitelman's syndrome. The cancer is cured but its treatments have left me with chronic pancreatitis, bilateral neuropathies of both feet, degenerative jaw disease, and a totally collapsed lumbar spine with accompanying radiculopathies from L-1 through S-1. I am transitioning from terminal care models to a technology assistive environment with the adjunct of Synthetic THC Dronabinol. From total immobility and assistance to move, I now workout at a gym every other day, eight hours a week. Through nausea and anorexia control enabled by Dronabinol, I have been able to gain strength and energy because I now enjoy my the whole eating experience. Tolerating three times the amount of food I used to eat, 80% fresh fruits & vegetables as I have for a lifetime. Dronabinol reduced my dependency for care high care dependency as an invalid with little mobility, to an active senior. Two years into taking it I am swimming for the first time, at 73. I have been working out for over a year now. I gym three times a week for 2 hours a session. It is amazing how quickly I am getting stronger. Over a three month period my recovery rate has gone from 2 hours after a distance of 100 yard taking 40 minute to swimming 100 yards in 7 minutes with a 10 minute recovery. All this is because I am no longer starving to death. This drug stopped the starvation and has saved my life. I think it should get more publicity so people can learn about its benefits. I am trying to use my blog as a social media platform to inform my audience that there is life after cancer and the nausea, pain and suffering it leaves in its wake. My blogging skills keep improving and I hope it helps my chances of doing more on social media to advance the causes of senior activism and the alternative use of Synthetic THC as a pharmaceutical.
